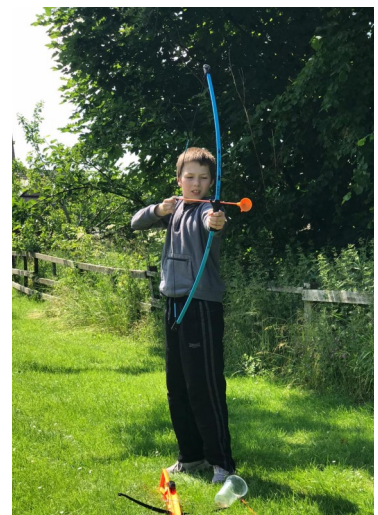


### Fun Fridays with Action Ants
