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#### **Running Track**

We are all very excited, particularly Mrs. Idle, because her hard work planning and organising has come to fruition! We are working with a

company called Edspace and they are fitting a polyurethane bound rubber, all weather daily mile track with a length of around 270metres. This will allow the children to use the field in the soggiest of weathers! The children will be able to walk, run, cycle and scoot on the track, so it will be very useful for all age groups! 6 laps of the track = 1 mile! The work should take around 5 days, and then we will be able to use the track for our PE and playtimes!

## Family Orienteering Challenge



This session will be for regular orienteers only due to COVID restrictions. However, in the following weeks, there will be a family orienteering challenge available which you can complete using our new map.

The challenge will be to visit all of the checkpoints indicated on the map, in any order. At each location there will be a question for you to answer e.g. what is the number on the lamp post?

You can either print the map out or just use it on a smartphone or tablet. The challenge will be open for a few weeks and you can complete it all at once or in small sections over several evenings.

More details will be sent out nearer the time. We will be teaming up with Friends of Shap School (FoSS) to raise money for their work as part of the challenge and you will be in with a chance of a reward for a full set of correct answers!
